1. Students enroll in one 3 credit or 4 credit course per term, plus up to two Living the Culture courses per Summer term. Please consult the Spanish Studies Abroad website or Brochure for individual course prerequisites.
2. Summer programs have a prerequisite of 3.0 overall GPA.
3. Students may select LTC 491PS, Paddle Surf, for one term only. Students may enroll in LTC491SVL, Service Learning, LTC491D, Regional Folk Dance in both Term 1 and Term 2 or for just one term.
4. Students must have completed **one semester of advanced college-level Spanish**, or equivalent, prior to arrival in Seville for INT 490S, SVLS 490 and LTC 491SVL. Separate application for Internships and Service Learning Course Options.
