2. You must enroll in a minimum of 12 credits and a maximum of 16 credits for each semester. The recommended course load is 13 credits (reduced due to shorter program)..
3. If you select a 400-level course, you must have prior experience in a pertinent field of study; see descriptions and prerequisites in the Spanish Studies Abroad website or Brochure.
4. Experiential Learning opportunities have a prerequisite of one course in advanced college Spanish prior to the program and are approved in Seville. On this preregistration form you may indicate that you wish to enroll in an Experiential Learning opportunity, but must select a full course load from non-Experiential Learning courses, in the event that your selection is not approved.
