The Summer Term aligns with the beginning of the fall semester in Argentina. During this 4-week period, students have the option of choosing one 80-hour intensive language course or one or two 45-hour content courses. After consulting with your advisor, please choose courses following the guidelines below:

1. Each student selects one 5-credit language course, one 3-credit content course, or two 3-credit courses, for a total of 80, 45, or 90 hours respectively. If a student scores a *Básico* level in the placement test, it will be mandatory to take a 5-credit language course.
2. Courses meet Monday through Thursday.
3. Minimum 3.0 GPA in Spanish coursework. Enrollment in individual courses, especially language courses may have additional prerequisites; consult the Spanish Studies Abroad website or Brochure for details.
4. UNC/PECLA reserves the right to cancel courses due to low enrollment. Internships and service learning projects are approved in Córdoba. Students applying to an internship or service learning project must select an alternate course in case the internship is not approved.
5. Students enrolling in INT 490ANS or SVL 490ANS may only enroll in one 3-credit course.
